





Theatre gave me comfort not only within myself but also provided me with a community of support during adolescence- a tumultuous time I am sure we all remember fondly. I am so lucky now to have the opportunity to provide this same sense of community to the students of RCHS and I do not take my responsibility lightly. It is truly a magical experience to witness the students create and explore together.

I want to thank my family and friends; Mom and Dad, for always being there to support me, always. Megan, for being the best sister a brother could ask for and for enduring Survivor marathons with me.

To the cast and crew- I am so honored to be your director. You all amaze me with your wit, creativity, and talent.
